John 6:35-40

³⁵ Then Jesus declared, 'I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty. ³⁶ But as I told you, you have seen me and still you do not believe. ³⁷ All those the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never drive away. ³⁸ For I have come down from heaven not to do my will but to do the will of him who sent me. ³⁹ And this is the will of him who sent me, that I shall lose none of all those he has given me, but raise them up at the last day. ⁴⁰ For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise them up at the last day.'

- ⁵ In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus:
- ⁶ who, being in very nature God,
 - did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage;
- ⁷ rather, he made himself nothing
 - by taking the very nature of a servant,
 - being made in human likeness.
- ⁸ And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death – even death on a cross!
- ⁹Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name,
- ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,
- ¹¹ and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
